

Facilities & Services Parking Department Parking Deck Facts

At the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign campus we have five parking decks of various vintages:

Deck C-10 (5th and Daniels – Champaign)

The 336-space deck was completed in 1969. The structure is cast-in-place post tension. The exterior is brick masonry and concrete wall caps. The elevated slabs are treated with an applied membrane system. This deck was substantially renovated in 2004 including electrical, lighting, slab and tendon repairs along with a major modification to the stair tower.

Deck C-7 (Sixth and John – Champaign)

This 309-space “twin” to deck C-10 was built in 1969 as well. It was substantially removed in the same manner in 2005. The notable difference is that deck C-7 has an elevator and deck C-10 does not.

Deck D-5 (Gregory and Illinois – Champaign)

This 605-space is a facility that adjoins to the Krannert Center for Performing Arts. The deck was originally built in 1969. It was substantially renovated in 1996. The deck is cast in place and most of the deck is underground below the Performing Arts Center. The deck has elevator lobbies that lead into Krannert Center. The deck is used for employee parking in the day and performance parking in the evening.

Deck F29 (Dorner and Gregory – Champaign)

This 760 space facility was built in 1999. The deck is a post-tension cast-in-place. It has a pre-cast exterior. The deck has two glass stair/elevator towers. The ground level houses the University of Illinois Fire Department and work rooms for the Parking Department’s Meter Staff.

Deck B-4 (University and Goodwin – Urbana)

This 1,500 space facility was built in 2003. The deck is a double helix designed cast in place post-tension facility. The exterior is clad with brick imbedded precast panels. The deck has two glass elevator and stair towers. The north lower level was designed as lease space and currently houses office/laboratory space leased by the United States Geological Service. The south lower level features 18,000 square feet of leasable commercial space.

The cost to build ranges greatly based upon the age of the decks. The most recent deck, deck B-4 cost approximately \$16,000 per space to build. Current projected costs to build another deck are \$20,000 per space.
